If now is one of those times when you could use a helping hand, a Care Coordinator can help.

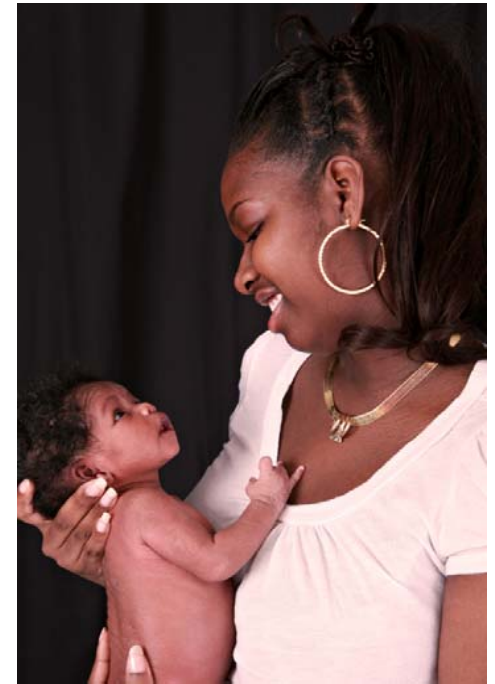
A Care Coordinator will listen to your concerns and help you connect with needed resources.
